

Young people trapped in low status

Mechanisms and ways out

This online workshop will present the results of extensive qualitative work with young people (aged 15-29) in four different European cities - Amadora in Portugal, Chemnitz in Germany, Corby in the UK, and Pécs in Hungary. We will discuss findings about how and what intersectional factors contribute to young people being trapped in a low socio-economic status, as well as about the ways out that can be identified.

Our comparative effort also resulted in several recommendations towards policy reforms, which will also be presented.
